For over 200 years, Crail Golfing Society has been home to some of the finest links golf in Scotland

In 1786, a group of eleven gentlemen met at the Golf Inn in Crail over a jug of punch and instituted the Crail Golfing Society. Over two centuries later, the Society is still going strong, now with 1,500 members from every corner of the globe.

In the early days, members would play on a narrow strip of land at Sauchope, dressed in distinctive scarlet jackets

with yellow buttons. Then, in 1895, golfing legend Old Tom Morris formally laid out the course at Balcomie Links.

Today, the course is considered one of the gems of Scottish golf. Offering breathtaking coastal views, challenging windswept conditions, and a character all of its own, Balcomie is also thought to be the inspiration behind the 'Burningbush' course of Michael

Murphy's bestseller, 'Golf in the Kingdom'. Its sister course at Craighead, designed in 1995 by Gil Hanse, is rapidly achieving a reputation in its own right as a modern classic, with no two consecutive holes facing the same direction.

Crail Golfing Society currently offers a limited number of Life Memberships to overseas golfers who are keen students of golf's history and traditions:


- Four rounds of golf per year on each of the two courses and eight member's tickets which you can pass on to friends, enabling them to play at a nominal rate.
